The **2009 flu pandemic** is a global outbreak of a new strain of influenza virus, identified in April 2009, and commonly referred to as "**swine flu**".

At this time, WHO (World Health Organization) considers the overall severity of the influenza pandemic to be moderate. This assessment is based on scientific evidence available to WHO, as well as input from its Member States on the pandemic's impact on their health systems, and their social and economic functioning.

SCA Packaging is reviewing its existing contingency plans for its sites and all business critical processes, to prepare for readiness in the event of major personnel absence due to the pandemic.

SCA Packaging Europe sites are taking (medical) advice from local/country authorities to protect health & safety of our employees and prevent business interruption. Information and recommendations to all our employees on how to reduce infection risks are in place.
